



COVID-19 Emergency Fund Grantees: Food & Basic Household Needs Support

Arab American and Chaldean Council - \$10,000 awarded to provide food for food-insecure families and to provide diapers and formula for at-risk families with infants and young children served by the AACC's community pantry in a "food desert" area of Detroit.

Brilliant Detroit - \$10,000 awarded to provide food for distribution, 'learn at home' kits, and other resources to more than 2,000 families with young children served by Brilliant Detroit.

Detroit Public Schools Foundation - \$7,500 awarded to provide food, diapers, and formula for at-risk families with infants and young children served by the Detroit Public Schools.

Development Centers, Inc. - \$10,000 awarded to be used to provide food for food-insecure and diapers and formula for at-risk families with infants and young children served by the Development Centers' early childhood programs.

Eastern Market - \$10,000 awarded to provide food distribution for families at Brilliant Detroit and other non-profit organizations that serve children and families.

Encore Catering - \$5,000 awarded to supply prepared meals to needy families via selected community partners and a \$5,000 commitment for a future event to assist them with organizational stability.

Food Bank of Eastern Michigan - Flint - \$10,000 awarded to support food distribution for at-risk families and vulnerable populations by providing drive through food distributions and home deliveries in response to COVID-19 demand.

Forgotten Harvest - \$10,000 awarded to purchase fresh food and shelf stable items to provide food distributions to community organizations and food pantries in response to COVID-19 demand.

Gleaners Food Bank - \$10,000 awarded to provide food distributions to community organizations and food pantries in response to COVID-19 demand.

Hope Network Foundation – Grand Rapids - \$10,000 awarded to support the Red Bus Relief Program for the delivery of supplies, meals, food, and medical support to children, families, seniors, and the medically fragile in the Grand Rapids Community.

Leaders Advancing Healthy Communities - \$10,000 awarded to provide food for food-insecure families who have lost access to community soup kitchens that have closed, and to provide diapers and formula for at-risk families with infants and young children.

Love for a Child - \$10,000 awarded to provide food and other emergency goods for food-insecure foster families.

Ronald McDonald House - \$5,000 awarded for required sanitation products to safely house guests and for increased costs for take-out food for guests as the communal kitchen had to be closed for COVID-19 transmission risks.

Starfish Family Services - \$10,000 awarded to provide food, diapers, formula and other basic needs to food-insecure families served by Starfish.

The Farm at St. Joseph Mercy - Ann Arbor - \$10,000 awarded to support food ordering/delivery for at-risk families in the Ypsilanti/Ypsilanti Township community in partnership with the Growing Hope food hub, which will collect, package, and deliver food to families.
